



TWO PERLS of UKRAINE. **Kyiv - Lviv**

8 days/7 nights

with English-speaking guide
(other languages for request)

Big, diverse and largely undiscovered, Ukraine is one of Europe's last genuine travel frontiers, a nation rich in colourful tradition, warm-hearted people and off-the-map experiences.



Day 1. KYIV/ arrival

Arrival to the one of the Kyivs international airport KBP or IEV.

You will be met by the company representative and transferred to your hotel and check in.
Time for leisure after a long flight.

By evening we will take a walk along the central street of Kiev - Khreshchatyk. Let's look at its architecture, monuments and luxury shops (like Louis Vuitton, Chanel, Bally, etc).

Kreschatik - central street of the city, one of the most popular places of public amusement. This relatively short street is one the list of the "mandatory" tourist sights of Kiev. The first buildings appeared there in 1790s.

Kiev is one of the biggest cities in Europe. It is a bustling capital of independent Ukraine, its administrative, economic, scientific, cultural and educational center.

Now is the perfect time to visit Kyiv, which is experiencing a mini cultural renaissance. Having only recently appeared on Western travelers' radars, the Ukrainian capital offers an array of attractions from its top-notch historic wonders to the exciting foodie scene.

Day 2. KYIV



Breakfast in the hotel.

City tour in Kyiv (1580 years old):

-St. Sophia Cathedral (founded in 1037)

-St. Michael's Cathedral

-Museum II World War with the monument "Motherland " (A colossal 62-meter statue of Motherland (102 meters) is made of special stainless steel and assembled with a special crane.).

-Andreevsky Descent - (also known as Kyiv's Monmartr") and one of "must see" places in Kyiv - Andreevskaya church.

In addition, we will see the Mariinsky Palace (1744, architect Rastrelli), the buildings of the Cabinet of Ministers, the Opera and Ballet Theater, the Taras Shevchenko State University, the State Philharmonic society and the National Bank of Ukraine.

Walk along Independence Square and we will see Kyiv from the best viewpoint.
After the tour - return to the hotel.

Day 3. KYIV



Breakfast in the hotel.

In the morning we will drive to the "Khutir Savky" Museum of Ethnic Culture of Ukraine.

Khutir Savky is open-air folk museum of pristine ukrainian culture. Today visitors can not only inspect the museum, but also get acquainted with the work of ancient appliances, household items and household utensils, which fills two estates from different regions of Ukrainian Polissya in 1786 and 1854.

After lunch (not incl) - a trip to the shopping mall "Ocean Plaza", the largest in Ukraine.

Day 4. KYIV – LVIV

Breakfast – box will be provided at the hotel. Early leaving the hotel. Transfer to the railway station. Departure to Lviv by train (the journey will take around 5 hours/550 km). Arrival to Lviv. Transfer to the hotel and check in.

Lviv... Mysterious and architecturally lovely, this Unesco-listed city is the same authentic Central European charm as pre-tourism Prague or Kraków once did. Its quaint cobbles, bean-perfumed coffeehouses and rattling trams are a continent away from the post-Soviet badlands of the east. It's also a place where the candle of Ukrainian national identity burns brightest.



After lunch (not incl) - walking tour in the Old Town:

- Market Square
- Prospekt Svobody with the Opera and Ballet Theater
- Armenian and Dominican Cathedrals

- Boim Chapel and High Castle
- The souvenir market, unusual picturesque restaurants and much more.

Day 5. LVIV



Breakfast in the hotel.

Visit the chocolate, gingerbread, coffee and caramel stores, which show the processes of making products. You can cook something delicious for memory yourself!

After lunch (not incl) - a trip by the dungeons of Lviv.

Explore enigmatic undergrounds of Lviv and uncover their secrets during the walking tour with a local guide. Listen to the legends about ghosts in the twilight of the labyrinths and plunge into the atmosphere of mystery.

Dinner at the Lviv restaurant.

Day 6. Lviv region, the CARPATIANS.

Breakfast.

Check out from your hotel and transfer to the excursion.

Visit the three famous castles of the Lviv region: Zolochiv, Olesko and Pidhirtsi, known as “the Golden Horseshoe”. Admire beautiful architecture and learn interesting facts and legends about each castle.

This trip is a great way to spend your day.



Lunch during the excursion (not incl).

Transfer to Lviv.

Then transfer to the railway station, boarding an overnight train to Kiev (coupe for 4 persons).


Day 7. KYIV

Morning arrival to Kiev, breakfast.

Excursion to the Kiev-Pecherska Lavra, a visit to the underground caves and a museum of jewelry.

The Kiev- Pecherska Lavra church complex is a historic Orthodox Christian monastery situated atop the right bank of the mighty Dnipro River. The monastery was founded in 1051, today is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and was voted one of the Seven Wonders of Ukraine recently. There are truly few places in the world that are as strikingly beautiful and supremely tranquil. The complex includes 20 hectares of territory with 16 churches, two underground cave systems that contain the mummified remains of Orthodox saints and their relics, a central cathedral, seminary, and a (recently reopened after

reconstruction) 96.5 meter tall bell tower. This is a deep cultural experience.



After lunch (not incl) – visit to the one of the most famous and scandalous residences of Ukraine - the complex of ex-President of Ukraine Viktor Yanukovich - "Mezhyhirya".

There are few places on Earth like the \$75 million residence of Ukraine's notorious 4th president, Viktor Yanukovich. Since fleeing the country, this luxurious site, known as Mezhyhirya, has been opened to the public and has become a must-see destination for locals and tourists alike. From the ostriches in his private zoo, to the replica Spanish galleon, to the exquisite landscaping across the expansive 140 hectares of territory, you'll see firsthand why Yanukovich was named by Transparency International as the world's most corrupt politician in 2016. You won't want to miss this tour. Come and be amazed at how far corruption can go!

Return to the hotel.

Day 8. KYIV/ departure

Breakfast.

Check out from the hotel, transfer to International Airport (KBP or IEV), according to your flight time.

Meals: breakfast.
